From 1943 until March 1944 was Kommissar with S.D. The Hague under Kriminalrat SCHREIBER. Was 1st. assistant to SCHREIBER and during his absence, represented him on important conferences. Personal body-guard (?) of the former Befehlshaber of the S.D., Brigade-Fuhrer HARSTER, The Hague. Was latterly very close colleague of SCHREIBER. After termination of the "Nordpol" affair when authority to operate further w/o agents was taken out of the Abwehr in 1943, he tried to establish w/o communication with London through the agents, HEINRICH I, HEINRICH II and HEINRICH III. This lasted for a few weeks, but London immediately recognised the doublecross. His assistant in this was Ustuf. KAI.

German, about 52; slim, about 1.70 m.; dark brown hair; clean-shaven; modest civilian clothes, very seldom uniform; soft voice; speaks German without dialect; seen S.D. The Hague, 1943 till March 1944.

Secretary at the Sipo, The Hague, in the Vo. Zimmer of Kriminalrat SCHREIBER, Leiter of IV 3 from 1942/43. Went, probably in the middle of 1944, to the S.D. Riga in order to avoid the attentions of V-mann VAN DER WAALS & ANTON & DE WILDE.

Also responsible for penetrating the Goss VORREIN group, through VENUS, and was the intermediary for passing the "Victory" messages, which were sent on the BONI line. He was motivated in his actions by his wish

to marry Fri. GEIGERMEYER, Civil Eng. SCHREIBER's secretary. In Sept. 1944 SCHREIBER told HUFFELANN that VAN DEN WALD was in England and had gone over on his own accord. VAN DEN WALD was reportedly murdered in 1943. It was a trick of the S.D. who had the news published in all north and south Dutch newspapers and offered a reward for the capture of the murderer. I do not know why this was done, probably to give him a fresh start as he was completely "blown" in Holland. His description was published in the Black List of the Dutch Resistance movement.

in the cases of

F.A.K. 307 and Subsidiary Trupps

Information on F.A.K. 307 and its subsidiary Trupps has been given by GISEES as follows:-

"In the winter of 1945/44, the situation from an Abwehr III point of view in France, Belgium, and to a certain extent in Holland, demanded an intensification of both offensive and defensive work of the German III.F section. According to knowledge to hand it was clear that:-

- a) The organisation of Resistance and sabotage groups, armed and equipped by the enemy, was making rapid progress.
- b) A well functioning W/T agent net with extensive means of communication was continually being expanded.
- c) Enemy espionage activity in regard to size and quality of results had turned out to be a military threat of the first order.

"The question was purely this: Could the German Oberkommando-West reckon on continually, if at all, being able to counter more effectively this menace, in view of:-

- a) Lack of means in regard to personnel and technical requirements.
- b) The readiness on the part of the civil population to make sacrifices which were bound to increase, whilst the difficulties of the Occupation authorities were augmented.
- c) Mistrust on the part of the A.S.H.A. towards everything that was not B.S. or Hartel, which resulted in all units under command of the A.S.H.A. trying to encroach on Abwehr territory.

"In view of this situation it was necessary first of all to withdraw the III.F services from the structure of Abwehrstellen and to form them into independent Trupps. The following military considerations led to the final order in this respect:-

- a) Putting the III.F units on a mobile basis for the event of a possible war of movement in the West.
- b) Stricter control, more uniform principles, and more rapid appreciation and analysing of the results.
- c) The placing of F.A.K. commanders directly under the Ic of Army groups and the Stabschefs of the military G-in-C, with a view to ensuring their continual and direct briefing and the immediate carrying through of orders regarding reconnaissance, or deception, of the enemy.

"My former activity as an Abwehr officer, within the normal meaning of the word, came to an end with the order to form, equip, brief and command, both technically and from a regimental standpoint, FAK 307, with its subordinate PAF's 362, 363, 364 and 365. As the area allotted to FAK 307 comprised the region from Baden to the mouth of the Somme, I had to keep the Wehrmacht's C-in-C for Holland, as well as the military C-in-C for Belgium and Northern France, continually informed concerning the enemy espionage (Abwehr) situation. This had to be carried out by means of regular conferences. The actual IIIF work was carried out independantly by the PAF's. (The case of JEDENBERG, who was run by the Kdo, was an exception to this rule). Apart from a few basic orders, the Trupp commanders were given a free rein in their decisions. The completion of the formation of the FAK and PAF's were continually delayed owing to the lack of personnel and material and had still not been completed by June 1944, in spite of the order which was issued in January 1944."

-----

HUNTSMAN states that FAK 307 had been stationed at Brussels since March 1944. The main part left Brussels on 3rd September, 1944, the remainder having left two days earlier, and went to the Schloss Hillenrand bei Roermond in Holland. From there, in the middle of September, the newly formed Staffel II (all superfluous staff, under the command of Hauptmann WUTER) was transferred to Kierspe-Bahnhof, where they remained until April 1945. These were people not suitable for the Abwehr and therefore redundant. The remainder of the Kommando went about the end of September to Bersdorf bei Bonn, and from there, a few days before the occupation of Bonn, to Hoenningen. In mid-March, 1945, as the front got nearer, the Kommando went to Huelinghausen bei Plettenburg in Westphalia, where it finally broke up.

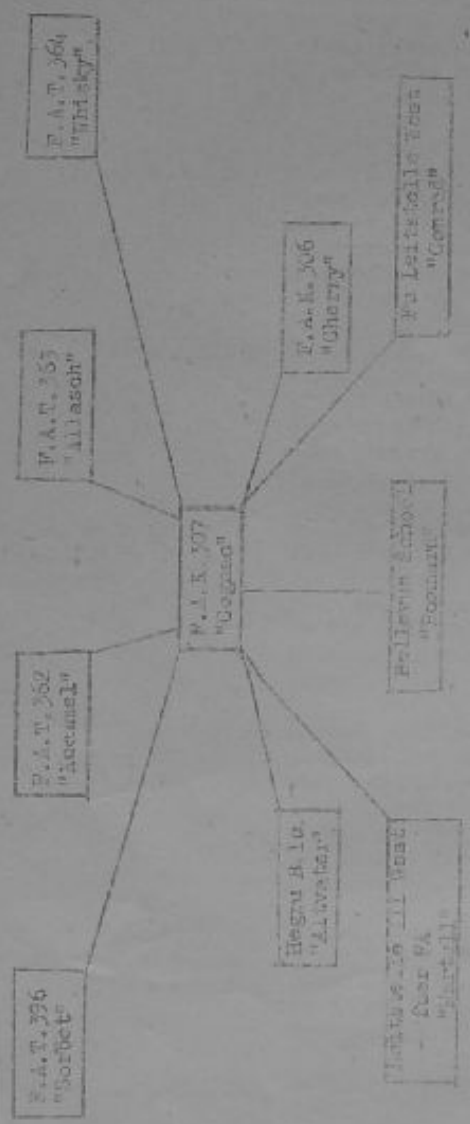

Many thanks for the Progress Report of 5.6.45. This fully confirms my previous impression that these two are co-operating to the best of their ability.

The further steps to be taken on the S.O.E. angle were fully discussed at yesterday's meeting with S.O.E. and there is no need for me to comment further.

The preliminary statements made by these two about LINDBERG are interesting and interrogation on this point in the light of LINDBERG's own story should produce good results.

Strap, who handled the LINDBERG case, has made the following comment: -

"Some of the information given regarding LINDBERG is new to us. There had hitherto been no evidence that LINDBERG gave away or could have given away any Allied military plan. The theory that he had been responsible for passing information regarding the Arnhem operation was based on a misreading of the information from most secret sources. Nor were we previously aware of the fact that LINDBERG had been put in touch with agents who were parachuted into the northern Dutch province. The incident to which GISEKS refers may well relate to the penetration of the organisation which S.O.E. attempted to set up in the spring of 1944, when the organisation which had hitherto succeeded was proved to be utterly penetrated. I am, however, somewhat surprised by GISEKS' statement that the attempt to play back S.O.E. agents was immediately spotted in England.

I should, however, be grateful if progress reports could be issued from time to time dealing with general III. matters e.g. activities of Amt. VI 2, and the old Abw. III D, Leitstelle III West, relations of III with S.M.A., long term plans if any, general instructions on penetration matters, machinery for deception through controlled agents, particulars of deception plans and cases. Such progress reports on the more central III organization, as distinct from the local activities in Holland and of the BAK's and BAI's will be most useful in interrogating Oberst. HSILE who has just arrived at C.S.D.I.C. (U.K.).

GISKES and HUNTINGMANN

Mention has already been made of agents from the school at Wicl called Christian Henri TOUTAIN @ CLAUDE and two other men who were to undertake mission NORA. TOUTAIN and one of the others has been arrested and I enclose a copy of the preliminary field reports. The missions given early in April. Contact was to be made between the end of May and 15th June. According to TOUTAIN he was told, when given his instructions in April, that the war was lost but the service would continue. This suggests that the mission was a post collapse mission and it is stated in a cable that the nature of the instructions indicate a long range programme. We have not yet received details of this programme - apparently precise mission and questionnaire only to be given after contact had been established either by V/T or through the Paris telephone number or through the letter boxes in Liechtenstein.

Another point is that in the field report HUNTINGMANN states that TOUTAIN had been parachuted by the G.I.S. into North Africa in 1941 and has worked for the Abwehr ever since. This is, of course, in direct contradiction with TOUTAIN's preliminary interrogation and the field have therefore asked urgently regarding TOUTAIN's Abwehr service to assist them in interrogation of TOUTAIN which is now proceeding.

I should be grateful, therefore, if you could let me know as quickly as possible, in the first instance by telephone, the answers to the following points:-

- (a) Details of TOUTAIN's Abwehr service
- (b) Comments on the mission likely to have been transmitted to these agents in June.
- (c) Any explanation of the suggested contacts in Paris or Liechtenstein.

As the completion of the interrogation of GISKES and HUNTMANN at Camp 020 and the preparation of interim reports is likely to take some time I am departing from the usual practice and am sending you a Progress report in duplicate which you may find of interest.

In particular I draw your attention to the reference to Stelle "F" in Appendix III page VIII. You may also find some leads to help in the rounding up of some members of III F in Holland, particularly Appendix III part (a) No. 26, 31 and 22, and Appendix III (b) No. 1. The references to LINDMANN in Appendix IV are extremely interesting and suggest that he had been even more active in the German interests than had been realized. I leave it to you whether you think it is now worthwhile trying to follow up further what access LINDMANN had to operational information.
