Member of KDO. 307, acting as liaison agent between Brussels Aussenstelle and FAK.KDOs. Known at Drierbergen where he was director of W/T traffic with home station and at the same time directed a false traffic from Abwehr Trupp 365, which was known as 'Fall Nordpol'. Ten different lines were maintained on this traffic which had been kept up to a year and a half. The traffic was partly handled by OHEO Drierbergen and partly by arrested agents. HUNTERMAN knew that his game was spotted after November 1943, because agents who had been arrested in Autumn 1943 escaped and informed the British. He closed down his traffic with a message which he sent over all ten lines - 'To Major Bingham, Blunt & Co., Ltd. Thank you for your long mutual co-operation. In case you should come to the continent, I shall receive you with the same care as your agents' Later moved to HQ Brussels, where he was attached to staff of Aufkl KDO.307.

Arranged rendez-vous between DAMEN and VAN VLIET, and during December asked DAMEN the name of the W/T operator on his last ship (D. was 4th engineer officer on K.P.M.line) then sent message to UK using this man's name (ROBERS); he was told by UK to come up again after Christmas. Left for Berlin in Sept. 44.

Reference your PF.601,832/WROLA of the 26th July, 1945. The above mentioned was recruited by us in May, 1941, and left for the field in March, 1942, and was arrested on arrival.

According to our information he was executed at Mauthausen camp on 6th September, 1944, and therefore there appears to be no need for him to be carded as an undesirable character unless there is any possibility that the report of his execution was untrue. I do not, however, consider the possibility of this to be very great.

I have read this file with the very greatest interest. It is most amusing to read how the Germans encountered the same difficulties as we did in running double-agents, and especially in conducting bogus acts of sabotage. In this connection I think Christopher Harner and Victor Rothschild would be extremely interested to see a copy of the report.

One of the most interesting features is that they only employed two of the agents themselves to operate their own wireless sets. The others, I understand, were imitated by members of the German w/t organisation in Holland. If SOE had employed their wireless fingerprinting method properly—which I know was in existence in about 1943—they should surely have been able to discover that their own agents were not operating the sets. One point I would like to have cleared up is - did they take the precaution of operating wireless sets from the districts where the agents were supposed to be located? This, I think, is a very important point, as it was one which you remember was considered of primary importance in cases which we were running.

So far as the distribution of this report is concerned, I think it is essential that Noakes should have a copy for his own private use, since he is after all responsible for CI in Holland. Brief details of these two cases were given in the monthly summary for June. Their interrogation has now been completed and Interrogation Reports fully describing the history of these two efficient members of the enemy counter-intelligence service have been published. In addition, a full report has been made out with the co-operation of S.O.E. on the successful penetration of an S.O.E. organisation in Holland. This matter was brilliantly handled by the Germans who obtained control of a W/T set early in 1942 which they played with the result that they were able to arrest each subsequent agent as he arrived until at one time they were operating as many as 15 wireless links simultaneously. The deception was not discovered in London until the autumn of 1943. In the course of the deception clever use was made of staged sabotage, and in particular an old bulk of about one thousand tons loaded with wrecks of old and damaged aeroplanes was deliberately blown up in full view of the public of Rotterdam.

Another interesting incident related by GISEKS is that at the end of November 1944, GISEKS, as commander of FAK 307, was given by I/C Heeres Gruppe B a list of locations of formation and unit H.Q. in the area of Munchen Gladbach and Dueren with instructions that this was to reach the Allies as coming from a first class source. The package was given by a member of the PAT 364 in plain clothes to a foreign worker who was attempting to regain Allied territory. The worker was acting in good faith and did not know that his passage across the lines was being assisted by the Germans. Enclosed in the package was a covering letter stating that the information emanated from a group of German Communists trench-digging close behind the German lines, and asking for a wireless broadcast to be made from Radio Luxembourg mentioning the words "Otto von Sachsen" to indicate safe reception of

Many thanks for the Interim Reports and the separate WORTPOL report in these cases. It seems to me that these two have very fully covered the activities known to them. I have no supplementary questions to ask on behalf of the War Room although it is possible that other Departments, particularly S.C.E., may wish to put certain further questions. Everything these two men say is fully consistent with other sources of knowledge.

There are one or two points which I have not expressly raised on which it is just possible, although not perhaps probable, that GISKES might have some useful information.

- GISKES has dealt as fully as he can with the playing back of Allied agents by III F and the attempts to deceive the Allies operationally. Is he aware whether operational deception was also passed through agents controlled by the Sipo and SD, particularly Amt IV?
- It is known that Amt IV in France and Belgium were controlling some Russian W/T agents and sending to Moscow false traffic. This activity seems to have been controlled by a certain PANWITZ sent from Amt IV 2 A for the purpose. There is said to have been a certain amount of liaison between Amt IV and

- 3. Captured documents show that one Helmuth WEHR, a man of many aliases and a red beard covering a receding chin, was engaged in a great deal of penetration and deception work both during the war and for some years beforehand. Before the war he acted as right-hand man for PROTZ, then head of III F at Abwehr HQ, and he presumably continued to work for Abwehr III F Berlin. Does GISENS happen to know anything about this man, or his activities?
