HISTORY.

(1) Education: Elementary School in Almkerk, Secondary School in Rotterdam. When 17 years of age he first worked in an office for about 1 year and then went to the Dutch Post & Telegraph Service as wireless Operator, where he remained.

(2) Before the war he was too young to take an active part in politics, but his parents and consequently he himself, belonged to the Conservative Party. After the invasion of Holland he became a member of the A.N. Party (Conservative).

(3) In March 1938 he started his compulsory Military Service with the 22nd Regt. Inf. in Ede, and was released as a Sergeant in March 1939. He was mobilised on the 29.3.39. and was

ferred to the Engineers. During the invasion he was stationed as a Listener at the Wireless Station in Voorburg.

(4) He was demobilised on 8.6.40, and resumed his work in Amsterdam, working as a wireless Operator and actually still serving on Saturday 14.2.42. HENNING is a Service friend of his.

(5) On Saturday the 14.2.42, he received a visit from De HAAS, who was sent by HENNING, advising him to get ready to escape from Holland. On Sunday he was phoned by De HAAS, telling him to come at once to IJmuiden. He met them there and they left in the evening.
