No. 21 Physically not so well built as Rolfs but resembles him in other ways. Keen sense of independence, reliable. Nevertheless he has a more cunning and shrewd character than R. He doesn't mind "poser" as the French say. constantly asking the most foolish questions during lectures, exasperating the instructors at times. Difficult to tell whether he is sincere or "pose". I ascribe it to the same thing all Dutchmen have in common, to look at things from a far too problematic angle making everything look far more complicated in their own minds than it is in reality.
